Introduction

The Committee on Statistics, at its sixth session held in November 1985, decided that ESCAP should produce a statistical pocketbook containing principal series and key indicators for the region based on data already available within the secretariat. *Asia-Pacific In Figures* is the outcome of that decision.

Asia-Pacific In Figures is intended for those who need to know at a glance the basic features and trends in the region. The explanatory notes provided should facilitate an understanding of the data, which cover many important socio-economic aspects of development.

The data presented in this edition of *Asia-Pacific In Figures* refer to 57 countries or areas. Wherever possible, official government data have been used. Where official government figures are not available, the tables draw on data from the United Nations and other international sources.

The designations employed and the presentation of the material in this publication do not imply the expression of any opinion whatsoever on the part of the Secretariat of the United Nations concerning the legal status of any country, territory, city or area, or of its authorities, or concerning the delimitation of its frontiers or boundaries.

Unless otherwise stated, reference to "tons" indicates metric tons, and the term "billion" signifies a thousand million.

Explanatory notes

POPULATION STATISTICS

Total population. Unless otherwise specified, figures shown for total population are mid-year estimates (i.e., 30 June or 1 July) or averages of year-end estimates, provided by national statistical offices. As far as possible, the population statistics presented are de facto (present-in-area).

Age distribution. Data were supplied by the Population Division of the Department for Economic and Social Affairs and the rates were computed in the ESCAP Statistics Division.

Rural residence. Classification of population by rural residence is provided by country or area.

Annual crude rate of live births and deaths. Data refer to the number of live births and deaths per 1,000 population which occurred or were registered during the period indicated.

Rate of increase. The rate of increase is the annual percentage change in population size.

Density. Data refer to the number of persons in the total population per square kilometre of the total area.

SOCIAL STATISTICS

Infant mortality rate. The number of deaths to infants under one year of age in a given year per 1,000 live births in that year. Data exclude foetal deaths.

Expectation of life at birth. Defined as the average number of years expected to be lived by a newborn baby, assuming a fixed schedule of age-specific mortality rates.

Adult literacy rate. Literacy rate refers to the percentage of adult population (age 15 years and over) who are able to read and write. Semi-literate persons who can read but not write are not included.

Primary school enrolment ratio. Data refer to gross enrolment ratio, which is the total enrolment of all ages divided by the population of the specific age groups, corresponding to the primary school age group. The ratio may exceed 100 if the actual age distribution of pupils extends beyond the official school ages.

Population per physician. Physicians are persons who are graduates of a medical school or faculty and are actually working in the country in a medical field.

Daily newspapers: circulation. A newspaper is considered to be "daily" if it appears at least four times a week.

Telephones. Data refer to the number of main lines in operation. Main telephone lines refer to the telephone lines connecting a customer's equipment to the public switched-telephone network (PSTN) and which have a dedicated port on a telephone exchange.

Mobile cellular telephones. Data refer to subscribers of portable telephones subscribing to an automatic public mobile telephone service using cellular technology which provides access to the PSTN.

Television receivers. Data refer to the number of all types of television receivers in use, for receiving broadcasts to the general public, including those connected to cable distribution systems. Private sets installed in public places and communal receivers are included.

Daily calorie and protein supplies. Data refer to energy equivalent of per capita net food supplies available in the country per day. Food supplies comprise domestic production, imports less exports and changes in stocks. Net supplies exclude animal feed, seeds, quantities used in food processing and losses in distribution. The food requirement has been estimated on the basis of physiological needs for normal activity and health, taking into consideration environmental temperature, body weight, and age and sex distribution of the population in the various countries or areas, and allowing for waste at the household level.

Emissions of CO₂. Data are calculated by the Carbon Dioxide Information Analysis Center located at the Oak Ridge National Laboratory. National emissions of CO₂ from industrial sources are derived from United Nations consumption data for gas, liquid and solid fuels plus cement manufacturing and gas flaring statistics to which appropriate emission factors have been applied. Emissions are in units of 1,000 metric tons of carbon; to convert carbon into carbon dioxide, multiply data by 3.67.

EMPLOYMENT

Population employed. Data refer to all persons above a specified age who, during the specified period of either one day or one week, were working.

Population employed in agriculture. The agricultural sector comprises agriculture, forestry, hunting and fishing.

Female labour force. The number of women in the labour force as a percentage of the total labour force.

ENERGY

Commercial primary energy production. Included in the production of commercial primary energy for solids are hard coal, lignite, peat and oil shale; liquids are comprised of crude petroleum and natural gas liquids; gas comprises natural gas; and electricity is comprised of primary electricity generation from hydro, nuclear, geothermal, wind, tide, wave and solar sources.

Commercial energy consumption. Data refer to the consumption of commercial energy for solids, liquids, gases and electricity, expressed in kilograms per capita of oil equivalent.

NATIONAL ACCOUNTS

Data on national accounts refer to the summary data for national accounts and compiled according to the System of National Accounts (SNA).

Gross domestic product and per capita gross domestic product. Unless otherwise indicated, total and per capita gross domestic product are in purchasers' values. Gross domestic product in purchasers' values is defined as (a) the difference between the gross output value of resident producers minus the value of their intermediate consumption plus duties, (b) the sum of domestic factor incomes (i.e. compensation of employees and operating surplus), indirect taxes net of subsidies and consumption of fixed capital, (c) the sum of government and private consumption expenditure, gross capital formation in fixed assets and stocks and exports minus imports of goods and services. Private consumption expenditure measures the expenditure of all resident non-government units, which includes all households and private non-profit institutions serving households. Data on per capita gross domestic product in United States dollars are derived by converting national currency into United States dollars based on the average official exchange rates for the period. The official exchange rate might differ significantly from market exchange rates.

EXTERNAL TRADE

Exports and imports of goods and services. Exports and imports of goods and services include broadly the equivalent of general exports and imports of

merchandise as defined in external trade statistics, plus exports and imports of services and direct purchases abroad made by resident households and by the government on current account. Transfers of migrants' household and personal effects and gifts between households are also included. Exports are valued free on board (f.o.b.), whereas imports are valued on the basis of cost, insurance, freight (c.i.f.), unless otherwise specified.

GOVERNMENT FINANCE

Total revenue. Data refer to all non-repayable government receipts, whether required or unrequired, other than grants: revenue is shown net of refunds and other adjustment transactions.

Total expenditure. Data refer to all non-repayable payments by government, whether required or unrequired and whether for current or capital purposes.

Expenditure on government functions of education, health and economic affairs and services expressed as a percentage of total government expenditure.

INTERNATIONAL FINANCE

Domestic saving. Defined as the difference between current receipts and current disbursements.

External debt. Data refer to total debt stocks. Defined as the sum of public and publicly guaranteed long-term debt, private non-guaranteed long-term debt, the use of International Monetary Fund credit, and short-term debt.

Money supply: money. Data refer to the liabilities of the monetary system in currency and demand deposits to the domestic private sector.

Money supply: reserve money. Data refer to the liabilities of the monetary authorities in currency and demand deposits to deposit money banks and the domestic private sector.

International reserves, minus gold. Data refer to the United States dollar value of monetary authorities holdings of special drawing rights (SDRs), Reserve Position in the Fund, foreign exchange and the sum of these items which is Total Reserves minus gold.

Gold reserves. Data refer to official holdings of gold expressed in physical terms (millions of fine troy ounces).

Foreign exchange rate. Data refer to the units of national currency required to purchase one United States dollar and pertain to the period average. For some countries or areas, mid-point rates (i.e. the average of buying and selling rates) are used.

PRODUCTION

Agricultural production index. The index of agricultural production covers all crops and livestock products of a country. The index numbers of food production cover commodities considered edible and containing nutrients. Thus coffee and tea, although edible, are excluded because they have no known nutritional value.

Industrial production index. Data refer generally to mining, manufacturing and electricity, gas and water, and do not include construction unless otherwise indicated.

PRICE-INDEX NUMBERS

Consumer price index numbers show the movement of the cost of selected goods and services that are considered representative of the consumption habits of the country as a whole. When the index refers to a city, it is so indicated.

Wholesale price index numbers measure changes in the level of commodity prices at a non-retail stage of distribution. Data usually represent a mixture of producer and wholesaler prices for domestic goods. The index may cover the prices of goods imported in quantity for the domestic market.

LAND USE

Total land area. Data refer to total area, excluding area under inland water bodies. Inland water bodies generally include major rivers and lakes.

Arable land and land under permanent crops. Data refer to land under temporary crops (double-cropped areas are counted only once), temporary meadows for mowing and pasture, land under market and kitchen gardens (including those cultivated under grass) and land temporarily fallow or lying idle, land cultivated with crops that occupy the land for long periods and do not need to be replanted after each harvest, land under shrubs, fruit trees, nut trees and vines. Excluded is land under trees grown for fuelwood or timber.

Irrigated area. Data refer to areas purposely provided with water, including land flooded by river water for crop production or pasture improvement, whether this area is irrigated several times or only once during the year stated.

Non-arable land and land not under permanent crops. Data refer to any other land not specifically listed under arable land and land under permanent crops. This may refer to items such as permanent meadows and pastures, forests and woodland, built-on areas, roads, barren land etc.

TRANSPORT

Passenger-kilometres. Figures for railways relating to passenger-kilometres include all passengers except military, government and railway personnel when carried without revenue. Figures for civil aviation relate to revenue scheduled traffic of the airlines registered in the country for total operations (international and domestic). Revenue scheduled traffic is traffic for which remuneration is received and which is carried on flights performed according to a published timetable.

Passenger vehicles in use. Passenger cars refer to vehicles seating not more than nine persons (including the driver), including taxis, jeeps and station wagons.

TOURISM

Data on tourist arrivals refer to persons travelling for pleasure, health, business, meetings, study (including students and young persons staying abroad) etc., and stopping for a period of 24 hours or more in a country (country of arrival other than that in which they usually reside). Data on tourist receipts are expressed in millions of United States dollars.
