ISLAMIC DEVELOPMENT BANK

Establishment

The Islamic Development Bank (or the Bank) is an international financial institution established in pursuance of the declaration of intent issued by the conference of finance ministers of muslim countries held in Jeddah in Dhul Q'adah 1393H, corresponding to December 1973. The inaugural meeting of the board of governors took place in Rajab 1395H, corresponding to July 1975, and the bank was formally opened on 15 Shawwal 1395H, corresponding to 20 October 1975.

Purpose

The purpose of the Bank is to foster the economic development and social progress of member countries and Muslim communities in non-member countries individually as well as jointly in accordance with the principles of Shari'ah i.e., Islamic law.

Functions

The functions of the Bank are to participate in equity capital and to grant loans for productive projects and enterprise besides providing financial assistance to member countries in other forms for economic and social development. The Bank is also required to establish and operate special funds for specific purposes including a fund for assistance to Muslim communities in non-member countries, in addition to setting up trust funds. The Bank is authorized to accept deposits and to mobilize financial resources through Shari'ah compatible modes. It is also charged with the responsibility of assisting in the promotion of foreign trade, especially in capital goods, among member countries; and extending training facilities for personnel engaged in development activities in member countries to conform to the Shari'ah.

Membership

The present membership of the Bank consists 56 countries. The basic condition for membership is that the prospective member country should be a member of the Organization of the Islamic Conference, pay its contribution to the capital of the Bank and be willing to accept such terms and conditions as may be decided upon by the IDB Board of Governors.

Capital

In 2002, the authorised capital of the Bank was increased to ID 15 billion and similarly, the subscribed capital was also increased to 8 billion.

Head Office and Regional Office

The Bank's Headquarters is in Jeddah in the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia. Two regional offices were opened in 1994; one in Rabat, Morocco, and the other in Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia. In July 1996, the Board of Executive Directors also approved the establishment of an IDB Representative Office at Almaty, Kazakhstan, to serve as a link between IDB member countries and central Asian Republics. The office became operational in July 1997.

Financial Year

The bank's financial year is the lunar Hijra year.

Language

The official language of the Bank is Arabic, but English and French are additionally used as working language.
